

Colorado Home Rule Portal FAQ's for Municipalities

Does the Home Rule Portal affect our “System of Record”?

This is not in any way a replacement to any municipality’s “system of record” for taxes. Our solution was developed, at the request of our business community, and is simply an option for the businesses that file with multiple home rule municipalities to remit taxes with a single upload.

In the portal, the business uploads a single file with their monthly tax information for each jurisdiction for both sales and use tax. From this data, the system calculates the taxes, the business remits payment in our online cart, and we then distribute the taxes and remittance forms to each municipality.

With the Home Rule Portal, can my jurisdiction receive electronic payments and returns?

Yes. Municipalities can choose to receive their payments electronically (via ACH Credit). With this option, the municipality also receives several other benefits.

- Electronic Payments (via ACH Credit)
- Online, Secure Access to Tax Form Data and Reports (PDF & Excel)
- Electronic Correspondence with Taxpayers

How does this work for MUNIREvs communities?

For our MUNIREvs communities, data from the Home Rule Portal is automatically imported into their MUNIREvs custom site, so no staff time at all is required to process Home Rule Portal remittances, just as with any other paperless remittance through MUNIREvs.

Is there any cost to jurisdictions to receive electronic remittances through the Home Rule Portal?

No. There is no cost to municipalities to receive taxes from the Home Rule Portal for those multi-jurisdictional filers that choose to use the portal.

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
